Pumpkin, wild mushroom and blue cheese strudel with white wine tarragon sauce (V)

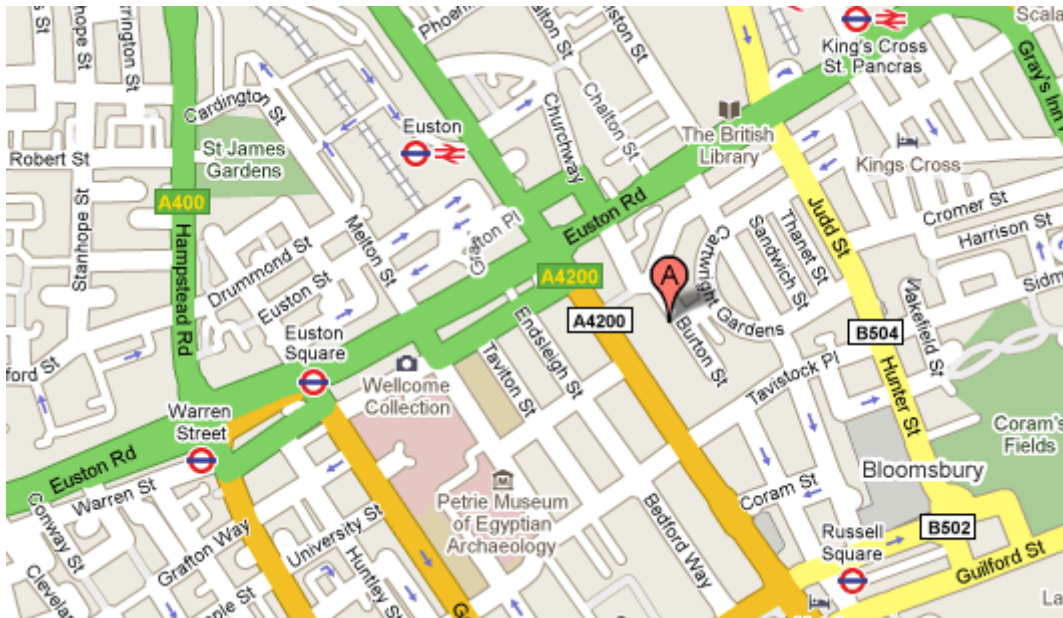

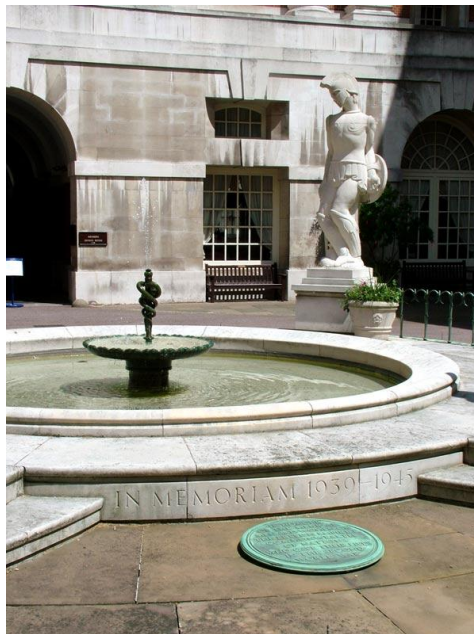
